

# *Handbell Week with David Weck*

## *Helpful Notes*

Here are some helpful hints and important information about the workshop:

### **WHAT TO BRING**

--Bottled Water (only water allowed in the workshop room/soda and coffee fine at lunch and other designated areas)

--Snacks, beyond those offered, as needed!

--Please wear comfortable clothing and shoes.

--Bring a carpet square to stand on--please nothing with a "prickly" backing that may damage the flooring.

--Clean rehearsal and WHITE performance gloves

--Concert clothing (black skirt/slacks/pants, white blouse/shirt)

--Black 3-Ring Handbell Notebook

--Music riser if you have one

--3 Hole Punch to punch music for binders on first day if you have one (optional, but helpful, some available for use as well)

### **FACILITY NOTES**

Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, Madison, has two locations.

--The **CENTRAL CAMPUS** (located at Raymond Road & Whitney Way, Madison) is not being used for Handbell Week 2011. You are invited to Good Shepherd's Summer Worship at Central Campus on Monday evening at 6:30pm.

--The **WEST CAMPUS** (7291 County Highway PD, Verona) is the WORKSHOP and HB WEEK CLOSING CONCERT site. Please park in the UPPER Parking Lot (to your Left as you enter).

### **WHEN YOU ARRIVE**

--Please enter the main entrance and check in at the **REGISTRATION TABLE** with Dorothy Nottelson.

--Workshop check-in begins at 8am on Monday at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church--WEST CAMPUS (Verona). The church will be open by appointment on Sunday and by 7:30am on Monday for those bringing handbells and/or equipment.

--Dorothy will confirm your registration and give you your workshop packet including music, session schedule, name tags, and other important information.

### **BRINGING EQUIPMENT**

--**PLEASE** mark very clearly ALL of the equipment you are bringing with your church name or identifying mark.

--We are very grateful for those willing to support the workshop by bringing their handbells, chimes, and equipment.

### **MEAL & SNACK BREAK NOTES**

--A variety of quality meals are catered for lunch each day (included in registration). Lunch is served at 12 Noon in the downstairs level of the workshop site.

--You may choose to bring your own beverage for lunch--offered will be water, coffee, and iced tea. A soda machine is available.

--Lunch servings are planned at one serving of each item per person.

--A simple morning and afternoon snack are provided with a selected beverage.

### **DINNER OUT AS A GROUP (OPTIONAL)**

--A tradition of the workshop is to share dinner together on Tuesday evening at a local restaurant--"dutch treat", of course!

--Separate checks, order from the menu.

--Location for 2011 is Biaggi's Italian Restaurant.

--The HB WEEK Closing Concert is open to the public and includes the music from the workshop.

--Concert dress as noted above is required of all ringers. A women's and men's dressing area will be available one hour prior to the concert.
